Examination and Evaluation System

Fifth Deans' Committee deliberated on the examination and evaluation system being followed by different universities. The Committee recommended Uniform Grading system to be followed with uniform OGPA requirements for award of degrees at all levels and uniform conversion formulae to be followed for declaration of I, II and III divisions distinctions etc. It is proposed to adopt the system of Examination and Evaluation on the lines of the V Deans committee from the academic year 2017-18.

The proposed system of Evaluation is as given below.

Minimum Marks for passing the subject will be 50% as per recommendation of V Deans Committee (40% each in Practical and Theory exam for separate passing).

Other Provisions:

10 marks of Practical records are split into 2 parts as 5 marks for practical and 5 marks for assignments. Existing passing criteria has been reduced from 55% to 50% (by 5%). There is no provision of grace marks as per V Deans Committee of ICAR. Therefore, provision of Grace Marks is removed for the students admitted from academic year 2017-18 onward.

Remaining system of examination and marks allotment for theory and practical will remain unchanged.
